## **Baccalaureate Origins**

Each year the National Science Foundation (NSF) conducts the Survey of Earned Doctorates. Each person who has earned a research doctoral degree that year is surveyed, and among the questions asked are the Baccalaureate institution that the recipient had attended. The doctoral-granting institution is responsible for submitting the surveys, and consequently NSF has very robust data on the backgrounds of individual Doctoral recipients. These data are made available to the public at *nsf.gov* 

The table below presents data collected by the Higher Education Data Sharing consortium for a recent 10-year window. Listed rankings are based upon the overall rate of Doctoral degree production during the indicated timeframe and is determined by dividing the total number of Baacalaureate degree awarded by an insitution by the number of Doctoral degrees awarded.

Haverford College, between 2008 and 2017, produced Doctoral degrees at a rate of 14.35% and ranks tenth among all institutions.
