The Fords at Swarthmore

Buzzer beater: On the heels of their 11-point upset victory over then-No. 22 Gettysburg on Saturday, the Fords were forced to make a quick turnaround and hit the road for Monday night's match-up with the Washington Shoremen, a team one win ahead of the Fords in the league standings. History was on Haverford's side in the contest as the Fords have won the last five meetings between the two teams — by an average of 11 points — and nine of the last 10. Early on history seemed to be repeating itself as the Fords held the lead from the opening basket, but WC rallied for a 34-30 halftime lead. The Shoremen doubled their lead to eight points over the initial four minutes of the second half but the Fords chipped away eventually pulling ahead on a pair of **Brent Anderson** free throws with 5:58 remaining in the game. Four lead changes and more than five minutes later the score was tied at 57 with WC coming out of a timeout with the ball and 30 seconds on the game clock. Their leading scorer launched what

he hoped would be the game winner with 10 seconds on the clock but the shot was off the mark and **Anderson** snared the rebound. A quick outlet pass near half-court to **Greg Rosnick** drew a double-team sideline trap but **Rosnick** found teammate **Sam Permutt** alone under the basket for the game-winning layup with just one second on the clock ... **Rosnick** had a team-leading 19 points in the win while **Anderson** pulled down a team-high seven rebounds.

Fords against the Garnet: Though Swarthmore has just one win this season, they have always risen to the occasion when facing the Fords. A 6-18 team last year entered the final game of the regular season schedule against visiting Haverford and rebounded from a 13-point deficit to send the game to OT where the Fords finally pulled out the victory ... The 2008-09 Hood Trophy standings are at 4-1 in favor of the Fords entering tonight's men's and women's basketball games at Swarthmore.

Scouting the Garnet: In their last outing Swarthmore fell to visiting Muhlenberg 73-65 on Monday night. The loss was their 13th in a row ... Head Coach **Lee Wimberly** began his 22nd season on the bench for the Garnet this year ... Senior **Raul Ordonez** leads Swarthmore in scoring (12.4 points per game) and rebounding (8.2 per game) ... Sophomore **Sam Lacy** has a team-best 24 blocks on the year and is also the team's leader in steals with 25 ... Junior **Matt Allen** is the team's assist leader with 44 on the season ... The Garnet came into the season having to replace five graduated seniors that accounted for 66 percent of the 2007-08 team's scoring and 55 percent of their rebounds. A youthful and small squad entered the 2008-09 campaign knowing of the rebuilding task that lay ahead of them.

The last time they met: Haverford defeated host Swarthmore in last year's second meeting of the season by a 78-70 overtime score which gave the Fords the season sweep.
