# Haverford College Women's Basketball

## The Fords at Bryn Mawr College

**Last time out:** Haverford led for most of the first half, but saw Johns Hopkins take the lead with under two minutes to play in the first half — a lead they would never relinquish — en route to a 52-44 victory on Saturday. The Fords would lead for the majority of the first half, but their last basket came with 4:53 remaining and it allowed Hopkins to take the lead on two **Caitlin Sloane** free throws with 1:42 left. The Blue Jays escaped the first half with a 25-24 lead. Hopkins stretched its advantage to 36-29 after back-to-back layups from **Siobhan Callanan** at 14:59 in the second half. A 6-0 run by JHU gave Hopkins a 10-point advantage with 7:06 to play. **Kathleen Abels** hit two free throws a moment later to cut it to eight. HC's defense held the

Blue Jays to just one point in the next three minutes, but Hopkins still held a 45-41 advantage with 4:02 left ... **Abels** led all scorers with 19 points, including 6-of-7 from the foul line. **Brittany Lattisaw** was the only other Fords player in double figures with 14 points.

**In their last meeting:** Haverford used a 12-0 run out of the gate to defeat Bryn Mawr, 53-32, in early January. **Lattisaw** scored a game-high 20 points and shot 60 percent from the field and fell just one rebound short of a double-double. **Abels** drained four three-pointers and tallied 17 points. **Lattisaw** and **Abels** combined to score the first 10 points of the game.
