Haverford College Women's Basketball

The Fords vs. Bryn Mawr College

Last time out: Haverford won its first game of the season with a 73-56 victory at Penn State-Brandywine on Saturday. **Brittany Lattisaw** tied a career-high with 28 points, while **Kathleen Abels** set a career-high with 27 points. Abels drained four treys in the contest while Lattisaw scored 17 points in the first half. The Fords got off to a commanding lead early and led the entire game. After a 38-23 halftime advantage, HC held PSU at bay during the second half and extended the lead to 20 points with five minutes to play.

Tough stretch: The Fords are half-way through a stretch of six games in

12 days. Playing in the Fords favor is that the next two games are at home before they head to McDaniel on Saturday.

Record watch: Coming into tonight's game Lattisaw has 813 career points. At her current pace she is on track to surpass 1,000 points late in the regular season.

Tough D: The Fords held PSU-Brandywine to 56 points on Saturday. It was the fourth time in eight games this season HC has held an opponent under 60 points. Last season Haverford's defense accomplished the feat just five times all season.

Scouting the Owls: Bryn Mawr fell to Johns Hopkins on Saturday, 62-41. **Jessica Allen** posted her third double-double of the season with 17 points and 11 boards. The Owls trailed by three at the half, but Hopkins opened the second half on a 21-6 run ... **Katie Tarr** is in her fifth season at the helm for Bryn Mawr ... Allen is the Owls' leading scorer this season at 12.7 points per game. In early December she became the fifth Owl to score 1,000 career points.

Last time they met: Bryn Mawr swept the season series last year with a 50-46 win on Feb. 12, 2008.

Series record: Haverford holds the series record, 37-15, however the Owls have taken the last three contests. The Fords last win came on Jan. 25, 2007 - a 52-47 victory.
