# Haverford College Women's Basketball

## The Fords vs. Dickinson College

**Last time out:** Natalie Richman's tip-in on an inbounds play with 0.7 seconds showing on the game clock propelled the Fords into a 58-58 tie at the end of regulation against a shocked Oberlin College squad on Tuesday night. Though the Fords kept the momentum rolling scoring the opening six points of the over-time period, Oberlin was able to re-group and score 14 straight points to hand host Haverford a disheartening 72-64 defeat on the Gooding Arena floor. The Fords were led by **Brittany Lattisaw's** 14 points and Richman's double-double of 11 points and 10 rebounds.

**Tough stretch:** The Fords are in the midst of a stretch where they will play six games in 12 days. Playing

in the Fords favor is that three of the games are at Gooding Arena and one of the three road games is at nearby Penn State-Brandywine.

**Record watch:** Coming into tonight's game Lattisaw has 774 career points. At her current pace she is on track to surpass 1,000 points during the final week of the regular season.

**Tough D:** The Fords are amongst the best in the conference in a number of defensive categories. HC opponents are shooting just 35.9 percent from the field which is tops in the conference. Haverford has been defending the three well as opponents are shooting just 31.5 percent.

**Scouting the Red Devils:** Dickinson opened 2009 with a 68-52 victory at Stevenson University on Monday evening. Junior **Brooke Muller** led the way with a game-high 19 points, shooting 5-of-5 from the free throw line while handing out four assists. The Devils closed out the half with a 9-2 run to take a 30-23 advantage into halftime and held the lead the entire second half ... **Dina Henry** is in her fifth season at the helm for Dickinson. In her time at Dickinson, Henry set a school record for wins

in a season and led the Red Devils to two NCAA Tournament appearances ... Muller leads the Red Devils averaging 14.7 points per game. She is shooting better than 41 percent from the field.

**Last time they met:** Dickinson downed the Fords on Feb. 2, 2008, 75-40, at the Kline Center.

**Series record:** The Red Devils hold a 15-3 advantage since 1994, including 11 consecutive wins.
