The Fords vs. Gettysburg College

Last time out: An 11-3 run down the stretch pushed Haverford past host Ursinus on Thursday night, enabling the Fords to capture a 50-48 Centennial Conference victory over the Bears. What became a seven point Ursinus lead early in the second half quickly disappeared as the Fords once again pushed ahead, taking a 33-32 lead with just over 17 minutes still showing on the clock.

The host Bears clawed back in front, though, but Haverford's closing run finally put an end to the battle. **Brittany Lattisaw** notched her seventh double-double of the season and fourth in four games with 12 points and 18 rebounds in the victory.

Teammate **Kathleen Abels** added 11

points and six rebounds while **Sara Cram** chipped in with 10 points and seven boards.

Tough D: The Fords have held their last six opponents under 60 points for the first time since Jan., 1990. During this streak HC has held every opponent below its scoring average.

Scoring tandem: Haverford is only one of three schools in the conference that has two of the top-14 scoring leaders in the conference. **Lattisaw** is second at 16.6 points per game, while **Abels** is 14th at a 13.5 PPG. Washington and Muhlenberg are the only other schools with two scorers in that group.

Scouting the Bullets: Gettysburg cut a 12-point second-half deficit to just four with two minutes remaining at Franklin & Marshall on Thursday, but the host Diplomats canned 10-of-12 free throws down the stretch to hold off the visitors for a 74-65 decision ... **Mike Kirkpatrick** is in his 20th season as head coach. Kirkpatrick has over 260 wins at Gettysburg and has led them to the Centennial playoffs seven times ... The Bullets are led by **Caitlin Moser's** 15.2 PPG. **Allie Drechsler** is Gettysburg's

second leading scorer, averaging 10.3 per outing.

Last time they met: The Bullets won the only meeting between the two schools last season with a 64-45 victory at Bream Gymnasium.

Series record: Gettysburg holds a 19-0 series lead since 1994.
