Haverford College Women's Basketball

The Fords vs. Johns Hopkins University

Last time out: Haverford used an 18-3 second half run that spanned five minutes down the stretch to defeat visiting Washington, 69-64, at Gooding Arena on a snowy Tuesday evening. Haverford trailed by five points at the half but took the lead for good on an **Alejandra Alvarez** three with 5:12 remaining. A **Brittany Lattisaw** break-away lay up with 13:07 remaining in the second half pulled Haverford within one, 41-40, but a 10-0 Washington run over the next four minutes made things look bleak for HC. A trey by **Alvarez** on the next possession sparked the run and fittingly she gave the Fords the lead for good on a three. **Kathleen Abels** and **Sara Cram** followed **Alvarez's** first three-pointer with treys of their own to make the score 53-49.

Lattisaw bested her season scoring average by 10, finishing the night with 25 points. **Natalie Richman** posted her second straight double-double and fourth of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds. **Abels** and **Alvarez** finished with nine points a piece. All nine of **Alvarez's** points came from behind the arc.

Iron woman: It is safe to say that **Abels** has not spent much time with first-year head coach **Bobbi Morgan** this season, and that is a good thing. The senior guard rarely sits on the bench, leading the conference with 38.1 minutes per game. **Abels' 38.1** MPG is also the most in a season at Haverford. She already holds the third-highest average in that category when she played 37.1 MPG last season.

Scouting the Blue Jays: Johns Hopkins bested Franklin & Marshall, 66-64, on Thursday evening. **Kristin Phillips** hit two free throws with seven seconds left to take the lead and earn the win ... **Nancy Funk** is in her 22nd season at the helm for Hopkins. Last years Funk won her 500th career game and is one of eight Division III coaches who have reached the 500 win plateau ... **Lyndsay Burton** leads the Blue Jays with 15.6

points per game. Phillips averages a double-double with 12.6 PPG and 10.8 rebounds per contest.

Last time they met: Hopkins won the only meeting between the two teams last year with a 67-45 victory at Gooding Arena on Feb. 9, 2008.
