# Haverford College Women's Basketball

## The Fords vs. McDaniel College

**Last time out:** The Fords could not overcome a 13-point deficit in its home opener, falling to Elizabeth-town College, 59-53, last Saturday. With just under six minutes remaining **Brittany Lattisaw** started a string of nine straight points by Haverford. **Kathleen Abels** knocked down a pair of threes and **Alejandra Alvarez** added another that cut the deficit to two with 1:46 on the clock. The comeback would end there as the Blue Jays connected on 5-of-6 free throws down the stretch. Lattisaw led all scorers posting a double-double with 18 points and 11 boards. Abels added 14 points, connecting on four treys.

**See you in 2009:** After today's game the Fords will have a 23 day layoff until their next contest. A win

today would send HC into the break on a high note.

**One of three:** Haverford is just one of three schools in the Centennial Conference that has at least two players in the top-15 in scoring. Abels (13.5 points per game) sits in 10th and Lattisaw (12.5 PPG) is tied for 15th.

**Tough D:** The Fords continue to play well on defense - holding three of four opponents under 60 points. Haverford's defense is surrendering just 56.8 points per game, good for fourth-best in the conference.

### Scouting the Green Terror:

McDaniel halted a three-game losing streak by winning its last two games. The most recent was a 71-45 victory at Bryn Mawr to improve the Green Terror to 1-1 in the CC ...

**Becky Martin** is in her 28th season at the helm for McDaniel. Martin has over 400 career wins and has led the Green Terror to 13 conference playoff berths, one Middle Atlantic Conference division title, its first-ever Centennial Conference crown and NCAA playoff berth in 2002, a feat she pulled again twice in the next three seasons. Her team has posted 20-win campaigns in six straight seasons and advanced as far as the

Sweet 16 in the NCAA tournament ... McDaniel is led by **Ali Moreland's** 13.2 PPG. Moreland is the only McDaniel player that scores in double figures and she posted a season-high 20 points on Dec. 4.

**Last time they met:** The Green Terror took the season series last year with a 68-49 victory at Gooding Arena on Jan. 19.

**Series record:** McDaniel holds a 17-1 advantage in this series since 1994.

**Last Haverford win:** The Fords last win in this series came in 1996 by a score of 67-65 at Alumni Field House.
