Dan Crowley is in his eighth year on the Haverford coaching staff. Crowley was the head coach at Friends Central School after a distinguished playing career at Haverford. Crowley still holds the Haverford records for runs scored in a season (40) and runs scored in a career (129).

Tim McLean coached and played professionally in Belgium after graduating from Haverford College in 2006. McLean was an all-conference first baseman during his playing days at Haverford. Now an assistant coach for the Fords, he instructs the team's hitters and infielders.

Adam Huron, the college's all-time leader in innings pitched, is the Fords' former pitching instructor. Huron, a two-year captain for the Fords, has also served as the pitching coach for the Ocean Giants of the Atlantic Baseball Confederation Collegiate League.
