

## RECOGNIZING I-STEM NOUNS

**Memento:** A Third Declension Nouns is an i-stems if it is 1) a Neuter whose nominative ends in -e, -ar, -al; or a Masculine or Feminine whose 2) nominative singular ends in -is or -es and is Parasyllabic; or 3) nominative singular ends in -s or -x and stem ends in Double Consonants.
