

VERBA "Q" TIBI NON HORRENDIA ("DON'T FEAR THE "Q" WORDS)

There are three main categories of Latin "Q" words: **Strengthened Interrogative Pronouns**, **Indefinite Pronouns**, and **Indefinite** or **General Relative Pronouns**.

STRENGTHENED INTERROGATIVE PRONOUNS & ADJECTIVES

quisnam, quidnam (pron)	"who, what"
quisnam, quaenam, quodnam (adj)	"which, what"
ecquis, ecquid (pron)	"is there anyone who/anyone think that"
ecqui, ecquae, ecquod (adj)	"which, what"

INDEFINITE PRONOUNS

quidam, quaedam, quiddam	"whoever, whatever"
aliquis, (aliqua), aliquid	"somebody, something"
▶ changes to quis, quid after si, nisi, num, ne	
quispiam, quaequam, quidpiam/quodpiam	"who, what"
quisquam, quicquam	"anyone/thing at all"
quivis, quaevis, quidvis/quodvis	"anyone you like"
quilibet, quaelibet, quidlibet/quodlibet	"anyone you like"
quisque, quaeque, quidque/quodque	"each one"
unusquisque, unaquaeque, unumquidque	"each one separately"

INDEFINITE/GENERAL RELATIVE PRONOUNS

quisquis, quidquid/quicquid	"whoever, whatever"
quiqui, quaequae, quodquod	"whoever, whatever"
quicumque, quaecumque, quodcumque	"whoever, whatever"
