BEFORE YOU READ: Recall what has happened so far (better yet, quickly re-read the previous assignment). What do you think will happen next? If you can, try to answer this and the following questions **IN GREEK** using words and phrases contained in the reading.

VOCABULARY: What 8 words or phrases were important or prominent in the reading? Note the line number(s) where they appeared. If you had to look up the word, provide the dictionary entry for each word you listed and English equivalent.

DIFFICULTIES: Note any words, phrases, or passages that you cannot understand or gave you difficulty.

SUMMARY OF THE TEXT: Summarize what you think was most important or significant in this passage.

COMPREHENSION QUESTIONS AND DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: Write one or two (or more) factual questions about the text that you could ask others in the class. Write any questions about style and narrative that you would like to ask others in the class.

REFLECTION ON THE READING: how did you find the reading (easy? difficult)? How long did it take? Other thoughts?
