PLEASE NOTE: The Housing Office and the Ira de A. Reid Selection Committee will be coordinating the application and acceptance process for Ira de A. Reid House for the 2009-2010 academic year.

Students who wish to live at the Ira De A. Reid House must apply to and obtain permission from The Housing Office and Selection Committee. The Reid House accommodates six students in six single rooms.

Preference will be given to applicants who meet one or more of the following criteria: active in the BSL; are members of the African Diaspora interested in the culture and politics of Africa and the African Diaspora and seeking a culturally supportive environment; are involved in multicultural activities that affect Black students.

This application, properly filled out and signed by the applicant(s), must be submitted to The Housing Office, Chase Hall, 2nd floor, Suite 213 by 5:00 pm, Monday, March 23rd. LATE OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

EACH APPLICATION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY:

A Statement of Purpose which answers the following questions:

1. In what ways does the applicant believe the Ira De A. Reid House can both serve and affect the Haverford community?
2. How will living in the Reid House contribute to the applicant's personal, social and academic growth and the social and academic growth of other residents of the house?
3. How can the applicant help the Reid House become a more effective resource on the campus?

Applicants applying as either pairs or as a group should write a joint statement that meets the above criteria and is complete.

After March 23rd, applications will be reviewed by The Housing Office and Selection Committee and appointments for interviews will be arranged. Following the interviews, decisions will be made and students notified. Students will then work out their room assignments and provide this information to the Housing Office by 5:00pm, Friday, April 3rd.

Applicants should bear in mind that:

Living in the Ira De A. Reid House is a privilege and a responsibility. The first floor serves as the Black Cultural Center, a resource especially for the Haverford community of African descent, including past and present students, faculty, administrators and staff. Students living in the Reid House must be willing to facilitate the use of the common rooms for meetings and gatherings of students of color and the organizations that serve them. Housemates must graciously prepare for and welcome guests, alumni, and prospective students. They must be willing to consult with the OMA about what the house needs in the way of repairs and accoutrements; they must use supplies, equipment and furniture with care and maintain the common areas in good order. Students who live in the house may be off the meal plan. There is an upstairs lounge for residents.
