1. The Love Conquest... 1848. To QC
2. Card case, mother of pearl, 19th century, owned by Stephen Grellet. To 989 B
3. Watch and works, 1785, owned by Rebecca Jones. Inscription on back: "Sarah Birkbeck, of Castleford, Yorkshire to Rebecca Jones of Philadelphia. 1785." The works are unattached; two keys for winding. Jones received this watch on a trip to preach in England. To 989 B
4. Compass in case, 19th century, owned by Stephen Grellet. The initials "SG" and date "1807" are inscribed on the silver housing. Laid into leather case. To 989B.
