Box 6: Isaac Sharpless Papers, 1884-1950s

Appointment as Dean, 1884.. 1 folder (1 item).

Note: Isaac Sharpless was the first Dean of Haverford College

Comfort, Howard (secretary of the Board of Managers) to I.S. Philadelphia, 1884 5/9.
[announces Board's recommendation to appoint IS as Dean of Haverford College, and includes a list of his duties]

Letters of Isaac Sharpless, 1887-1917. 1 folder (ca. 100 items)

Note: These are letters that were selected, typed and transcribed by Sharpless' daughter, Katharine Sharpless Klein. They are directed to members of his family, particularly to "Lily" and as Klein suggests in here preface to the letters, they indicate his character, especially his sense of humor.
