

PAPERS FROM THE PRESIDENCY OF ROBERT B. STEVENS

The following list describes the materials left behind from Robert B. Steven’s nine year tenure at Haverford College. The materials have been kept in four separate, roughly chronological divisions according to the four different filing cabinets in which they had been stored. They are referred to here as Collections 1,2,3, and 4. In addition, there is a fifth collection that consists of the speeches made by Robert B. Stevens both at and outside the college during his presidency. The list is divided to reflect which materials are in which of the archives’ boxes.

Collections 1 and 2 represent materials from the academic years 1986—87 and 1985—86 respectively, although they may also contain materials from previous years.

Collections 3 and 4 do not contain materials from such well—defined time periods. For the sake of convenience, Collection 3 will be referred to as materials from 1984—85, and Collection 4 as “pre—1984.” However, the two collections have considerable chronological overlap both with each other and in some cases with the material from more recent years. In addition, there is some material left from the presidential tenures of Steve Cary and John Coleman in these last two Collections and particularly in Collection 4. All miscellaneous alphabetical files from before 1985—86 are contained in Collection 3.

Some of the materials from the original files have been retained by the Office of the President for convenience of reference or for maintenance of confidentiality. Most of these materials will be released to the Haverford College Archives in the year 2013.
