

THE MULTICULTURAL SCHOLARS PROGRAM FUNDING FOR SCHOOL BREAK INTERNSHIP

MSP is offering an internship program over winter and spring breaks for students interested in exploring careers related to science. Through our grant from the Howard Hughes Medical Institute, we can offer stipends of \$200 per week for up to 15 students per break during our winter and spring breaks.

CRITERIA:

- You must be active in MSP.
- You need not be a science major, but the internship must be science or health related to be funded. Possible placements could be with governmental agencies, the media, hospitals or health clinics, museums, schools, environmental centers, law offices, public interest groups, pharmaceutical companies, etc. We have a list of alumni who could be potential mentors for your internship; other placements are possible.
- If you receive funding, you are expected to complete at least 30 hours of internship work experience during either the fall, winter or spring break.
- Submit the application for funding to Jeff Tecosky-Feldman via campus mail or deliver it to his office (Hilles 207e) .
- You will need to ask two Haverford College staff or faculty members to serve as references. (Do not ask them to write letters; we will contact them.)
- Applications will be reviewed by the faculty members of the Hughes Program Coordinating Committee
- After your internship, you must write a 1-2 page report describing your experience and its educational value. Submit this report to Jeff Tecosky-Feldman one week after the break ends.
