<p><b>Haverford Train Station Pick-ups</b></p>	<p><b>SUNDAY EVENING OCT. 16 ONLY</b>, the Tri-Co van will be used to pick up students at the Haverford train station. The first pickup will be made at 6:45pm on the Westbound (outgoing) side of the station; the next pickup will be an hour later, at 7:45pm, continuing each hour until 11:45pm, which will be the last run.
