<p>Haverford Train Station Pick-Ups</p>	<p>SUNDAY EVENING NOV. 27 ONLY, the Tri-Co van will be used to pick up students at the Haverford train station.</p> <p>The first pickup will be made at 6:45pm on the Westbound (outgoing) side of the station; the next pickup will be an hour later, at 7:45pm, continuing each hour until 11:45pm, which will be the last run.
