

To all Haverford students:

I write to let you know that there was a burglary in Lloyd last evening (Monday, October 20th). Access was gained through the student's dorm room window and a laptop and case were stolen.

We ask that you please keep your individual doors *and* windows closed and locked when you are not in your rooms and when you are asleep and that you report suspicious activity to Safety and Security (610.896.1111 -- 24/7).

We will be undertaking the inspection of all windows and window stops in Lloyd Hall, as well as all other ground floor dorm rooms. Facilities Management staff will be starting today, Tuesday, October 21, 2008, between the hours of 3:30 and 7:00pm, and will be going through rooms on the ground floor of the following buildings -- Lloyd, Leeds, Barclay, and Gummere. FM staff will announce their arrival into the building and will knock on individual doors before entering rooms. FM staff will, then, continue the inspection to the houses and the North Dorms. The HCA Management staff will be doing the inspections at HCA between the hours of 9:00am and 4:00pm.

It is imperative that these window safety devices not be removed or tampered with. I will be sending out information specific to each dorm about the window safety device in that dorm and how they work.

We greatly appreciate your cooperation through out this process.
