

How to get credit for math/stat courses outside Haverford

In order to get credit for math or statistics courses outside Haverford, students need to contact the department chair with the following information:

1. State explicitly what kind of credit you want to get:
 - a. Credit toward a requirement for the math major (specify which requirement), or;
 - b. Credit toward a requirement for the math minor (specify which requirement), or;
 - c. Credit toward a requirement for the statistics minor (specify which requirement), or;
 - d. Credit toward a requirement for a concentration (specify which concentration and which requirement), or;
 - e. Credit toward a college requirement other than the above (such as a divisional or Q requirement)
2. Provide course information for the outside course:
 - a. when and where is the outside course,
 - b. course description, prerequisites, course syllabus, how often the course meets, etc.
3. If you are a math major (or minor), talk to your major (or minor) advisor first before contacting the department chair.

Generally, the Department of Mathematics and Statistics does not give credit for online courses.

Once department chair approval has been granted, you will need to download the appropriate form from the registrar's office (<https://www.haverford.edu/registrar/forms>) and get the department chair's signature or get approval from the Study Abroad office (<https://www.haverford.edu/study-abroad>).
