Interim President Joanne Creighton relayed news about strategic planning from campus. The Task Force on Academic Enrichment, the working group on academic space planning, the Senior Staff, and many others have been identifying priority issues for the next phase of institutional development. The goal of the planning effort is to produce a strong first draft of the Plan by the end of the academic year, so that President-Elect Dan Weiss can bring the planning process to completion in 2013-2014.

Critical to the success of strategic planning will be the integration of financial planning in order to ensure an economic foundation for Haverford that is sustainable for years to come. The Board also continued its conversation about its own operating efficiency and committee structure, and it approved requests for faculty leaves for 2013-2014.
