Cohorts may be adjusted for: death or total and permanent disability; service in the armed forces (including those called to active duty); service with a foreign aid service of the federal government, such as the Peace Corps; or service on official church missions.

Financial aid status is as recorded in the students' first term.

Students who receive neither subsidized Stafford loans nor Pell Grant may have received other financial aid, or no aid.
