

## Research Continuity Fund

- 1. The purpose of the fund is to provide interim funding for research purposes for all tenure-track and continuing faculty that have been supported by external research support in the recent past but are in need of funds to cover a gap in funding. Equipment grants do not confer eligibility for this program.
- 2. Proposals: Faculty members seeking support from this fund should provide an explanation of the costs to be covered and how they relate to the recent external grant funding.
- 3. If appropriate, the Provost's Office may consult the relevant department Chair for help in evaluating the request.
- 4. The maximum amount of support would normally be 25-30% of previous outside funding (direct costs only) during the most recently funded one-year period. Normally, Research Continuity funds are available for at most a one-year period of performance.
- 5. Funds may not be used for student researchers, faculty summer salaries, or major equipment.
- 6. Funds may not be used as startup funds for new faculty members.
- 7. Awards from the Research Continuity Fund do not affect eligibility for awards from the Faculty Research Fund or the Student Assistant Fund.
- 8. At the end of the award period, a report must be filed with the Provost's Office providing information about the activities and outcomes from the funded work.

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
